4. Judges will be the Seaton Valley Council Services Officer and an officer of Northumberland County Council's Neat team and possibly one other judge. There will only be three people attending your property on judging day.
5. A list of winners will be available on the website.
6. All entries must be received by 7 July 2023. Any entries received after this date will not be entered into the competition.
7. Please ensure you have provided a postal address and contact details on the entry form.
8. No plastic or artificial flowers are allowed in any category.
9. The judges' decision will be final.
10. Judges reserve the right to disqualify entrants if they consider that the entrant has breached any of these terms and conditions.
11. No photographs are needed with your application as photographs will be taken during the judging period; however, you can if you wish to send us photographs of your displays at their best.
12. By entering the competition, you agree that you will allow the judges to view and photograph your entry.
13. The personal data supplied on this application form will only be used by Seaton Valley Council for the purpose of our Gardening Competition. The data will not be shared or published without your permission.
